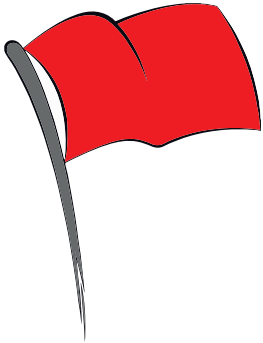




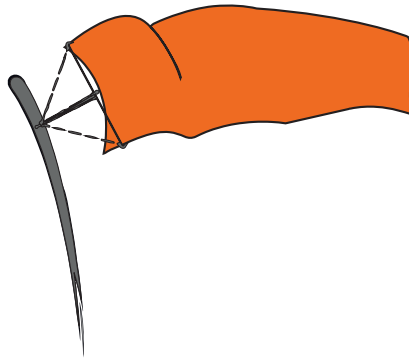
BEACH FLAGS DEFINITIONS

Top Tip

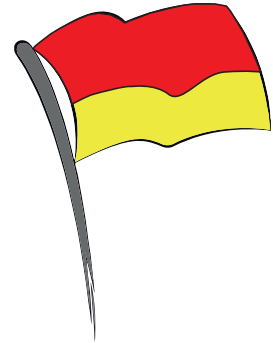
To help stay safe on the beach learn what each flag means.



Red: Danger, no swimming.



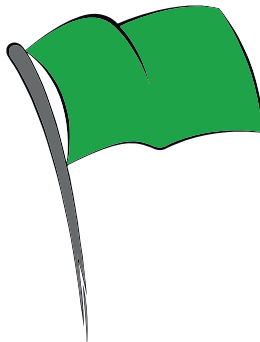
Orange Windsock: Shows the direction of wind. Off shore winds can sweep you out to sea and make it difficult to return to shore.



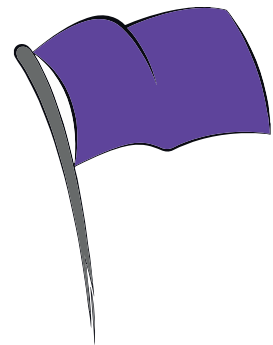
Red and yellow: Lifeguard on duty – always swim between the flags.



Black and white chequered: Safe for boats and water crafts only. No Swimming.



Green: The water is calm. This doesn't make the water safe; you must still be careful and look for areas where a lifeguard is present.



Purple: Dangerous marine life has been spotted e.g. sharks, jellyfish etc.
